

Chiapas Tour Itinerary

Price: \$15,200 pesos per person including travel costs, accommodation, breakfasts, boat ride in the Sumidero Canyon, entry fee to Palenque and guide. **Single person supplement:** \$2,000 pesos. **Price does not include** tips for your guide, drivers or hotel staff. **Minimum suggested tips:** \$50 pesos per day for guides, \$30 pesos per day for drivers and \$20 pesos per night for hotel room.

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: Travel to San Cristobal de las Casas

Travel by bus to Guadalajara airport (approximately 5 hours), followed by flight to Tuxtla Gutierrez (approximately 2 hours) and transfer to San Cristobal de las Casas (approximately one hour). Orientation, dinner and accommodation in San Cristobal de las Casas*.

**Departure times will be confirmed upon confirming flights; in the event of an evening arrival, accommodation will be in Chiapa de Corzo, where the tour on day 2 begins.*

Day 2: Sumidero Canyon

8am: Breakfast in hotel (included).

9am: Departure to Chiapa de Corzo, where we embark on a 2 hour boat ride through the magnificent Sumidero canyon followed by return to San Cristobal de las Casas and afternoon walking tour of the historic centre. Accommodation in San Cristóbal de las Casas

Day 3: Indigenous town of San Juan Chamula

8am: Breakfast in hotel (included).

9am: Departure to the indigenous towns of San Juan Chamula and Zinacantan to learn about the Mayan descendents known as the Tzotzil and their traditions and beliefs, including traditional medicine and textiles.

Day 4: Misol-Ha and Agua Azul

7am: Breakfast in hotel (included), followed by 8am departure to Palenque National Park, via the beautiful waterfalls of Misol-Ha and Agua Azul (total travel time approximately 7 hours on curvy roads). Accommodation in Palenque National Park. **It is recommended that you take your bathing suit and a light towel/sarong for this part of the trip.**

Day 5: Palenque ruins

7.30am: Breakfast followed by guided tour of one of the most famous Mayan archaeological sites. The ruins of this great city date as far back as 226BC up until its demise in the 12th Century AD. Accommodation in Palenque National Park (swimming pool here).

Day 6: Return travel

Travel from Palenque to Villahermosa airport (2 hours on bus), followed by flight from Villahermosa to Guadalajara and return travel by bus**.
