

Copper Canyon Tour Itinerary

Price: \$20,400 pesos per person* including transport, accommodation, 12 meals (mentioned throughout itinerary) and guide. **Single person supplement:** \$1,700 pesos. **Price does not include:** meals not mentioned in itinerary, tips for guide or bus drivers. **Minimum suggested tips:** \$50 pesos per day for guides, \$30 pesos per day for drivers and \$20 pesos per night for hotel room.

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Departure times to be confirmed upon confirming flights.

Day 1: Travel to Guadalajara by bus (aprox. 5 hours), check-in at hotel followed by time for lunch then afternoon walking tour of Guadalajara's historic centre (optional, no extra cost). Optional group dinner (not included in price).

Day 2: Transfer to Guadalajara airport for flight to Los Mochis then bus to El Fuerte. Arrival to hotel in El Fuerte (swimming pool at hotel), followed by walking tour then free time for dinner (dinner not included). Optional river tour available from hotel.

Hotel: Posada del Hidalgo (Beautiful colonial mansion converted into 5 star Resort & Spa).

Day 3: Breakfast (included) followed by Chepe train from El Fuerte to Bahuichivo and transfer from Bahuichivo to Cerocahui; followed by lunch (included) and guided walk through the town of Cerocahui, including visit to a boarding school for Tarahumara girls. Dinner included on return to Cerocahui.

Hotel: Hotel Misión (Beautiful hotel with landscaped gardens, orchards and charming courtyard).

Day 4: Breakfast (included) in hotel, followed by tour to the 'Cerro del Gallego' (a fantastic viewpoint for admiring the Urique Canyon), then train ride from Bahuichivo to Barrancas. Arrival to hotel, followed by lunch (included) and afternoon guided walk to Tarahumara caves and viewpoints of the Copper Canyon. Dinner included.

Hotel: Barrancas Mirador (Beautiful hotel on the edge of the Copper Canyon with exceptional views).

Day 5: Breakfast (included), followed by visit to the famous 'Piedra Volada' (flying rock) and spectacular views from the cable car station. Optional extras include cable car ride into canyon, zip lining through canyon and basket weaving with the Tarahumara ladies. Lunch and dinner included.

Hotel: Barrancas Mirador.

Day 6: Breakfast (included), followed by departure by bus to Chihuahua including stop at viewpoint in Divisadero and lunch with a Mennonite family (included) (approximately 5 hours travel time, not including stops). City tour in Chihuahua, including Pancho Villa Museum and Government Palace.

Hotel: Quality Inn (large modern hotel located in city centre).

Day 7: Breakfast (included) followed by departure for Chihuahua airport for return travel.
