

Querétaro Wine and Cheese Tour Itinerary

Price: \$8,700 pesos per person including travel costs, accommodation, breakfasts, wine & cheese tours, 2 lunches and guides. **Single person supplement:** \$2,200 pesos. **Price does not include** rest of meals and tips for your guide, drivers or hotel rooms. **Minimum suggested tips:** \$50 pesos per day for guides, \$30 pesos per day for drivers and \$20 pesos per night for hotel room.

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: León

6am: Travel to León (approximately 8 hours, packed lunch provided on the bus).

Afternoon arrival in León. Check-in at hotel followed walking tour of historic centre and visit to the famous leather stalls/stores of León. Optional evening meal with group (not included in price).

Day 2: Querétaro

8am: Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by travel to Querétaro (approximately 3 hours). Check-in at hotel followed by city tour and free time.

Day 3: Wine and cheese

8am: Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by departure to Tequisquiapan. Walking tour/orientation in Tequisquiapan followed by visit to Quesos Néole for cheese making explanation, tasting and shopping.

Afternoon: visit to **Viñedos La Redonda** winery. Visit includes guided tour of the vineyards, production areas and a taste of two of their wines with a delicious lunch. Return travel to Tequisquiapan, check-in at hotel and free time in the evening.

Day 4: Peña de Bernal, dairy and wine

8am: Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by departure to Bernal for viewpoint of the world's 3rd largest monolith – Peña de Bernal, walking tour and free time for shopping.

Visit to **Rancho La Hondonada**; a large, 100% organic, dairy farm which produces dozens of award winning dairy products from milk and yoghurt to cheese, cream and cookies. Tour includes explanation of the grounds, cattle breeding program, recycling program and tasting (lunch included).

2.30pm: Depart for Frixenet winery for explanation on the processes involved in creating their delicious sparkling wines, includes one sample. Time to shop before returning to Tequisquiapan.

Day 5: Return travel

7am: Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by departure for Guadalajara; lunch and free time in Tlaquepaque.

3pm: Return travel, approximate arrival time 8pm.
