

Peru Tour Itinerary

Price: \$3,900 USD per person including travel costs*, accommodation, breakfasts, 8 lunches, 8 dinners, boat ride on Lake Titicaca, train and entry fee to Machu Picchu and guide. **Single person supplement:** \$580 USD. **Price does not include** tips for your guide, drivers or hotel staff. **Minimum suggested tips:** \$3 USD per day for guides, \$2 USD per day for drivers.

***Flights are included:** Manzanillo/Puerto Vallarta/Guadalajara to Lima return, Lima to Cusco and Juliaca (Lake Titicaca) to Lima.

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Flight times and departure times will be confirmed upon booking flights and then sent in a more detailed version of this itinerary with your pre-departure information.

PLEASE NOTE: this tour is not recommended for anyone who suffers from severe altitude sickness. **Cusco altitude:** 3,400 meters, **Machu Picchu altitude:** 2,430 meters, **Puno/Lake Titicaca altitude:** 3,810 meters.

Day 1: Travel to Lima, Peru.

Flights from Manzanillo, Puerto Vallarta or Guadalajara to Lima (via Mexico City), transfer to hotel and dinner (included). **Accommodation:** Lima

Day 2: Lima to Cusco

9am: breakfast in hotel followed by 10 am airport transfer for 1.30pm flight to Cusco. Lunch and dinner included as well as tea at hotel upon arrival to help with altitude. Time for relaxation in evening (hotel is in historic centre). **Accommodation:** Cusco

Day 3: Cusco City tour

Breakfast in hotel, followed by city tour in historic centre then visits to Qenki, Tambomachay, Puka, Pukará and the largest of the Incan temples, Sacsayhuaman. Return to hotel for lunch before heading to the artisan are of San Blas. Free time in evening. Lunch and dinner included.

Accommodation: Cusco

Day 4: Sacred Valley and Aguas Calientes

Breakfast in hotel followed by departure to the Sacred Valley, including Pisac (market and archaeological site), Urubamba and Ollantaytambo. 3.40pm train to Aguas Calientes, arriving at 5.10pm and transfer to hotel. Lunch and dinner included.

Accommodation: Aguas Calientes.

Day 5: Machu Picchu

Breakfast in hotel followed by local bus up curvy road to Machu Picchu (25 minutes) for 2 ½ hour guided then free time at site. 4.20pm train back to Ollantaytambo and transfer to Cusco, arriving approx 8.30pm. Lunch and dinner included. **Accommodation:** Cusco.

Day 6: Travel to Puno (la Ruta del Sol)

6.30am departure from hotel for bus journey to Puno, making several stops along the way, including the Incan ceremonial centre of Pukara, la Raya (the line dividing the Cusco and Puno regions), the Temple of Wiracocha and more. Lunch included along route, arrival to Puno approximately 5.30pm, dinner included. **Accommodation:** Puno

Day 7: Floating Islands of Uros and Taquile Island

Breakfast in hotel, followed by boat ride on Lake Titicaca, the world's highest navigable lake. Stops include the floating islands of Uros, with its traditionally dressed inhabitants offering rides in their reed boats, and a hike to the top of Taquile Island for spectacular views of the lake and a chance to see local artisans at work.

Afternoon return to Puno (boat ride to Uros Islands approximately 20 minutes, and a further 2 hours to Taquile Island). Lunch and dinner included. **Accommodation:** Puno

Day 8: Travel to Lima

Breakfast in hotel, followed by 9.30am transfer to Juliaca airport for 12.50pm flight to Lima. Free time in evening, lunch and dinner included. **Accommodation:** Lima

Day 9: Lima City tour and return travel to Mexico City

Breakfast in hotel followed by city tour and transfer to Lima airport for flight to Mexico City. Lunch included. **Accommodation:** Mexico City.

Day 10: Mexico City and return travel

Breakfast in hotel followed by optional city tour in Mexico City, or free time, then transfer to airport for flights to Puerto Vallarta/Manzanillo/Guadalajara.
