

Oaxaca Tour Itinerary

Price: \$18,200 pesos per person, including travel, accommodation, breakfasts and guide. **Single person supplement:** \$2,000 pesos. **Price does not include:** lunches, evening meals, entry fees or tips for hotels, restaurants or guides.

Minimum suggested tips (please note tips are based on service and this is a minimum amount we recommend, but please feel free to tip what you feel is deserving): \$50 pesos per day per person for guides, \$30 pesos per day per person for drivers and \$20 pesos per night per hotel room.

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: Travel to Oaxaca City

Airport transfer and flights to Oaxaca City (via Mexico City). Afternoon/evening arrival followed by orientation and dinner/free time. Times to be confirmed upon booking flights.

Day 2: Monte Alban and Oaxaca City Centre

8am: Breakfast in hotel followed by departure to the impressive Zapotec ruins of Monte Albán, one of the earliest cities in Mesoamerica (approximately 30 minutes by bus). Afternoon walking tour of Oaxaca City's historic centre.

Day 3: Rugs, Mezcal and the Arbol del Tule

8am: Breakfast in hotel followed by departure to Teotitlán del Valle and Tlacolula, famous for the production of traditional Zapotec style rugs and mezcal respectively. We learn about the history and tradition behind both products, as well as giving you the opportunity to purchase. We also visit the famous 'Arbol del Tule', the widest tree in the world.

Day 4: Mitla and Hierve el Agua

7am: Breakfast followed by travel to the Zapotec ruins of Mitla and the beautiful site of Hierve el Agua, where the minerals in the water springs have created an interesting rock formation resembling water boiling over the cliff edge. The water is cold, but you are able to go in for a dip! (Approximately 3 hours travel to furthest point).

Day 5: Black Pottery and Alebrijes

8am: Breakfast in hotel before heading to a traditional family workshop in San Bartolo Coyotepec to learn about the production of Oaxaca's famous black pottery, followed by a demonstration on how to make Oaxaca's famous Alebrijes in San Martin Tilcajete. (Approximately 1 hour to furthest destination).

Day 6: Return travel

Airport transfer and flights to Puerto Vallarta/Manzanillo or Guadalajara (via Mexico City). Times to be confirmed upon booking flights.
