

Chiapas Tour Itinerary

Price: \$19,800 pesos per person including travel costs (including flights), accommodation, breakfasts, boat ride in the Sumidero Canyon, entry fee to Palenque, once packed lunch, and guide. **Single person supplement: \$3,200 pesos.** **Price does not include** tips for your guide, drivers or hotel maids.

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: Travel to San Cristobal de las Casas – *Flight times will be confirmed once they have been booked.*

Airport transfer, followed by flight to Tuxtla Gutierrez (change of flights in Mexico City) and transfer to San Cristobal de las Casas (approximately one hour). Orientation, dinner and accommodation in San Cristobal de las Casas.

Day 2: Sumidero Canyon

8 am: Breakfast in hotel (included).

9 am: Departure to Chiapa de Corzo, where we embark on a 2-hour boat ride through the magnificent Sumidero canyon followed by return to San Cristobal de las Casas and afternoon walking tour of the historic centre. Accommodation in San Cristóbal de las Casas.

Day 3: Indigenous town of San Juan Chamula

8 am: Breakfast in hotel (included).

9 am: Departure to the indigenous towns of San Juan Chamula and Zinacantan to learn about the Mayan descendents known as the Tzotzil and their traditions and beliefs, including traditional medicine and textiles.

Day 4: Travel to Palenque

7 am: Breakfast in hotel (included), followed by 7.30am departure to Palenque National Park via Villahermosa and La Venta Museum-Park (packed lunch included), or via Agua Azul and Misol-Ha waterfalls. Approximate travel time via Villahermosa: 7 ½ hours; approximate travel time via waterfalls: 6 hours. *Please note: if the road via the waterfalls is considered safe, we will take this route; in the event it is unsafe we will take the Villahermosa route.* Accommodation in Palenque National Park.

Day 5: Palenque ruins

7.30 am: Breakfast followed by guided tour of one of the most famous Mayan archaeological sites. The ruins of this great city date as far back as 226BC up until its demise in the 12th Century AD. Accommodation in Palenque National Park (swimming pool here).

Day 6: Return travel *Flight times will be confirmed once they have been booked.*

Airport transfer for return flights from Villahermosa airport (via Mexico City).
