

### Morelia and Monarch Butterfly itinerary

**Price:** \$9,100 pesos per person based on double occupancy, including transport, accommodation, breakfasts, one packed lunch, guide and entry fees into Tzintzuntzan archaeological site and El Rosario Monarch Butterfly Sanctuary. **Single person supplement:** \$2,800 pesos.

**PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:** lunches, evening meals or **tips for guides, driver or maids.**

**This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.**

#### **Day 1: Travel to Morelia and City Centre Tour**

**6 am:** Departure to Morelia. Packed lunch provided on bus (approx. 8 ½ hours). Arrival to Morelia, check into hotel followed walking tour of Morelia city centre, then free time in the evening. Recommendations will be given for dinner options. **Accommodation in Morelia.**

#### **Day 2: El Rosario Monarch Butterfly Sanctuary**

**7 am:** Breakfast in hotel (included).

**8 am:** Departure to El Rosario Monarch Butterfly Sanctuary (approximately 4 hours). Uphill hike (approx. 45 minutes to 1 ½ hours) or horse ride (approx. 20 minutes, cost approx. \$100 pesos each way). Lunch inside the sanctuary (not included in price).

**4 pm:** Departure from El Rosario back to Morelia, free time for dinner. **Accommodation in Morelia.**

#### **Day 3: Tzintzuntzan, Pátzcuaro and Santa Clara del Cobre**

**7 am – 8 am:** Breakfast in hotel (included)

**8.30 am:** Departure for Tzintzuntzan (approx. 1 hour). Visit 'Yácatas of Tzintzuntzan' archaeological site (home to the last great capital of the Purépecha Empire) and Tzintzuntzan town plaza.

**12.30 pm:** Arrival to Pátzcuaro; check-in followed by time for lunch then walking tour.

**Afternoon:** Trip to Magic Town of Santa Clara del Cobre (optional, highly recommended, no extra cost), including demonstration on production of the town's famous copper pieces and free time for shopping before returning to Pátzcuaro (approximately 30 minutes each way). **Accommodation in Pátzcuaro.**

#### **Day 4: Pátzcuaro and Catrinas in Capula**

**8 am:** Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by optional walking tour with guide or free time.

**11.30 am:** Departure for Capula (approx. 45 minutes), the birthplace of Michoacán's famous clay catrinas (skeleton figures associated with Day of the Dead) to visit local artisan centre (time for lunch in Capula). **3 pm:** Departure for Ajijic, arriving approx. 7pm. **Accommodation in Ajijic.**

#### **Day 5: Lake Chapala and return travel.**

**8 am:** Breakfast in hotel followed by free time to enjoy Ajijic and have lunch.

**2 pm:** Departure from Ajijic for return travel (approx. 5 hours).
