

## Peru Tour Itinerary

**Price: \$4,050 USD per person** including travel costs\*, accommodation, breakfasts, 8 lunches, 7 dinners, boat ride on Lake Titicaca, train and entry fee to Machu Picchu and guide. **Single person supplement: \$650 USD. Price does not include** tips for guides or drivers.

**\*Flights are included:** Manzanillo, Puerto Vallarta or Guadalajara to Lima round-trip, Lima to Cusco and Juliaca (Lake Titicaca) to Lima.

**This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.**

Flight times and departure times will be confirmed upon booking flights.

**PLEASE NOTE:** this tour is not recommended for anyone who suffers from severe altitude sickness. **Cusco altitude:** 3,400 meters, **Machu Picchu altitude:** 2,430 meters, **Puno/Lake Titicaca altitude:** 3,810 meters.

### Day 1: Travel to Lima, Peru.

Flights to Lima (via Mexico City), transfer to hotel and dinner (dinner is included depending upon arrival time, in event of late arrival, lunch will be included in Mexico City airport).

**Accommodation:** Lima (Casa Andina Private Collection).

### Day 2: Lima to Cusco

Breakfast in hotel followed by airport transfer for flight to Cusco. Lunch and dinner included. Time for relaxation in evening (hotel is in historic centre).

**Accommodation:** Cusco (Casa Andina Private Collection).

### Day 3: Cusco City tour

Breakfast in hotel, followed by city tour in historic centre then visits to Qenki, Tambomachay, Puka, Pukará and the largest of the Incan temples, Sacsayhuaman. Return to hotel for lunch before heading to the artisan area of San Blas (optional). Free time in evening. Lunch and dinner included.

**Accommodation:** Cusco (Casa Andina Private Collection).

### Day 4: Sacred Valley and Aguas Calientes

Breakfast in hotel followed by departure to the Sacred Valley, including Pisac (market and archaeological site), Urubamba and Ollantaytambo. 3.40pm train to Aguas Calientes, arriving at 5.10pm and transfer to hotel. Lunch and dinner included.

**Accommodation:** Aguas Calientes (Casa Andina Private Collection).

**Day 5: Machu Picchu**

Breakfast in hotel followed by local bus up curvy road to Machu Picchu (25 minutes) for guided tour and free time. Evening train back to Ollantaytambo and transfer to Cusco. Lunch and dinner included.

**Accommodation:** Cusco (Casa Andina Private Collection).

**Day 6: Travel to Puno (la Ruta del Sol)**

Early departure from hotel for bus journey to Puno, making several stops along the way, including the Incan ceremonial centre of Pukara and la Raya (the line dividing the Cusco and Puno regions). Lunch included along route, arrival to Puno approximately 5.30pm, dinner included.

**Accommodation:** Puno (Casa Andina Private Collection).

**Day 7: Floating Islands of Uros and Taquile Island**

Breakfast in hotel, followed by boat ride on Lake Titicaca, the world's highest navigable lake. Stops include the floating islands of Uros, with its traditionally dressed inhabitants offering rides in their reed boats, and a hike to the top of Taquile Island (optional) for spectacular views of the lake and a chance to see local artisans at work.

Afternoon return to Puno (boat ride to Uros Islands approximately 20 minutes, and a further 2 hours to Taquile Island). Lunch and dinner included.

**Accommodation:** Puno (Casa Andina Private Collection).

**Day 8: Travel to Lima**

Breakfast in hotel, followed by transfer to Juliaca airport for flight to Lima. Free time or city tour (depending on arrival time), lunch and dinner included.

**Accommodation:** Lima (Casa Andina Private Collection).

**Day 9: Lima City tour and return travel to Mexico City**

Breakfast in hotel followed by city tour (if not taken on day 8) and transfer to Lima airport for flight to Mexico City. Lunch included.

**Accommodation:** Mexico City (Hotel Catedral).

**Day 10: Mexico City and return travel**

Breakfast in hotel followed by optional city tour in Mexico City, or free time, then transfer to airport for flight to Manzanillo, Puerto Vallarta or Guadalajara.
