

Nayarit Cultural Tour

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: Coffee, Compostela and Huicholes of Tepic

8 am: Departure to the town of Compostela (approximately 2 ½ hours), founded in 1540 by Spanish explorer, Cristóbal de Oñate. Tour of the town's historic centre, followed by a visit to Finca Citamayo to learn about local coffee production (lunch included at Finca Citamayo).

2.00 pm: Transfer to Zitacua, Tepic (approx. 1 ½ hours) to learn about the impressive artisan work and the history of the indigenous Huichol culture. Transfer to Tepic's historic centre for dinner (not included).

Accommodation Tepic.

Day 2: Island of Mexcaltitán de Uribe

7 am: breakfast in hotel followed by 8 am departure to the island of Mexcaltitán de Uribe (approximately 2 hours), a small island on Lake Mexcaltitán, inhabited by approximately 1,000 people. Here we learn about the products made using the water lilies from the lake and enjoy a delicious lunch (not included).

Afternoon transfer to San Blas (approximately 2 ½ hours).

Accommodation San Blas.

Day 3: La Tovara mangroves and San Blas

8am: breakfast in hotel, followed by boat ride on La Tovara lagoon to see local wildlife, including many different bird species and the American crocodile. Visit to the Fort of San Blas, followed by lunch on the beach (not included in price) and time for swimming.

Return travel to Bucerias/Puerto Vallarta, approximate arrival time 6pm.
