

Yucatan & Riviera Maya Tour Itinerary

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: Travel to Merida - *Departure times will be confirmed upon booking flights.*

Flights to Merida, followed by transfer, check-in and orientation. Suggestions for joining group for dinner (not included in price).

Accommodation in Merida.

Day 2: Uxmal and Merida

7 am: Breakfast in hotel followed by departure for Uxmal archeological site (approximately 1 hour by bus).

Uxmal is one of the most important archaeological sites of the Maya culture, thought to have been founded around 500AD; located in the Puuc region, the site is considered one of the Maya cities most representative of the region's dominant architectural style.

Afternoon: walking tour in Merida and free time*. Accommodation in Merida.

**Walking tour may be on day 1, depending on flight arrival time; in the event of walking tour on day 1, you will have free time in the afternoon/evening of day 2.*

Day 3: Chichén Itzá and Valladolid

6.30 am: Breakfast followed by departure for guided tour of one of Mexico's most famous archaeological sites, Chichén Itzá (approximately 1½ hours on bus).

Afternoon: Visit to Ikkil cenote (swimming optional) followed by travel to Valladolid (approximately 1 hour on the bus) for orientation.

Accommodation in Valladolid.

Day 4: Río Lagartos Biosphere Reserve

7 am: Breakfast followed by departure for Río Lagartos Biosphere Reserve (approximately 1 ½ hours by bus).

Afternoon: return to Valladolid for free time.

Accommodation in Valladolid.

Day 5: Tulum

7.00 am: Breakfast followed by departure for Tulum archaeological site (approximately 2 hours by bus).

Afternoon: Optional activities such as snorkelling/trip to Isla Cozumel.

Accommodation in Playa del Carmen.

Day 6: Return travel - *Departure times will be confirmed upon booking flights.*

Breakfast in hotel followed by free time/departure for Cancun airport for return flights.
