

EXPERIENCE MEX-ECO TOURS

Tolantongo Tour Itinerary

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: Travel to Ixmiquilpan

Flights from Puerto Vallarta, Manzanillo or Guadalajara to Mexico City, followed by transfer to Ixmiquilpan (approximately 2 ½ hours). Orientation, visit to historic centre, including XVI century ex-convent of San Miguel Arcángel, and welcome dinner in hotel. *Flight times will be confirmed once they have been booked.*

Day 2: Tolantongo

7am: Breakfast

7.30am: Transfer to Tolantongo (approximately 1 ½ hours) for full day with access to hot springs, caves, river and other activities, such as zip lining and suspension bridge. Accommodation in La Gloria – rustic cabañas close to Tolantongo park with their own pools and waterfalls.

Day 3: Tolantongo

7am: Breakfast

7.30am: Entry to Tolantongo (or option to stay in La Gloria) for more time to enjoy this beautiful location.

3pm: Transfer to the Magic Town of Mineral del Monte (approximately 3 hours). Orientation, dinner and accommodation in Mineral del Monte.

Day 4: Mineral del Monte

8am: Breakfast in hotel.

9am: Tour of the beautiful Magic Town of Mineral del Monte, a mining town that sits at 2,660 meters above sea level. Free time for lunch and browsing in the afternoon before returning to hotel.

Day 5: Basaltic Prisms and Mexico's first Magic Town

8am: Breakfast in hotel.

9am: followed by transfer (approximately 1 hour) to the Basaltic Prisms of Santa María Regla – a spectacular canyon made up of polygonal columns of basaltic rock from 30 to 50 meters high, created by the slow cooling of volcanic lava, located in Mexico's first Pueblo Mágico (Magic Town), Huasca de Ocampo.

5pm: Return travel to Real del Monte (approximately 1 hour) for dinner and accommodation.

Day 6: Return travel

Breakfast, followed by transfer to Mexico City airport for return flight. *Flight times will be confirmed once they have been booked.*

You will need:

Swim wear, aquatic shoes/sandals, sun screen, towel, and warmer clothes for evenings (particularly for Mineral del Monte).

Please remember that the price of your tour does not include tips for your guides or drivers.
