

## EXPERIENCE MEX-ECO TOURS

### Tolantongo Tour Itinerary

**This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.**

#### **Day 1: Travel to Pachuca**

Flight from Puerto Vallarta, Manzanillo or Guadalajara (depending on your departure location) to Mexico City (times to be confirmed upon booking flights). Transfer to Pachuca (approximately 2 hours). Orientation and visit to the historic centre.

Accommodation: Pachuca.

#### **Day 2: Tolantongo**

**7am:** Breakfast

**7.30am:** Transfer to Tolantongo (approximately 3 hours) for a full day with access to hot springs, caves, river and other activities, such as zip lining and suspension bridge.

Accommodation: Tolantongo

#### **Day 3: Tolantongo**

**8 am – 9 am:** Breakfast, followed by optional visit to La Gloria (another section of pools and river with spectacular views), and free time in Tolantongo.

Accommodation: Tolantongo

#### **Day 4: Mineral del Monte**

**8am:** Breakfast, followed by 9 am departure to Mineral del Monte (approximately 3 hours). Time for lunch, followed by a tour of this beautiful Magic Town of Mineral del Monte, a mining town that sits at 2,660 meters above sea level. Free time before transfer to hotel.

Accommodation: Mineral del Monte

#### **Day 5: Basaltic Prisms and Mexico's first Magic Town**

**8am:** Breakfast in hotel.

**9am:** Transfer (approximately 1 hour) to the Basaltic Prisms of Santa María Regla – a spectacular canyon made up of polygonal columns of basaltic rock from 30 to 50 meters high, created by the slow cooling of volcanic lava, located in Mexico's first Pueblo Mágico (Magic Town), Huasca de Ocampo.

**5pm:** Return travel to Real del Monte (approximately 1 hour) for dinner.

Accommodation: Mineral del Monte

#### **Day 6: Return travel**

Breakfast, followed by departure to Mexico City airport (times to be confirmed upon booking flights) for flights back to Puerto Vallarta, Manzanillo or Guadalajara.

#### **You will need:**

Swim wear, aquatic shoes/sandals, sun screen, towel, and warmer clothes for evenings (particularly for Mineral del Monte).
