

Valle de Guadalupe Wine Tour itinerary 2024-25

Please note this itinerary may be subject to change due to traffic conditions or other factors.

Day 1: Travel to Ensenada:

Flights to Tijuana from Puerto Vallarta, Guadalajara, or Mexico City - *flight times to be confirmed once we have purchased flight tickets.*

Transfer to Ensenada (approximately 2 hours). Orientation and free time for dinner.

Accommodation: Ensenada

Day 2: Ensenada and Santo Tomas

8 am: Breakfast in hotel.

8.30 am: Departure to La Bufadora (approx. 1-hour drive), one of the largest marine geysers in North America. Transfer (approx. 1-hour drive) to the town of Santo Tomás to experience the oldest winery in Valle de Guadalupe. Time for lunch, before return to Ensenada (approx. 1 ½ hours) to visit the Santo Tomas wine cellar, which occupies the building that was home to the first bank of the city.

Accommodation: Ensenada

Day 3: Valle de Guadalupe

8am: Breakfast in hotel.

9am: departure to Valle de Guadalupe, first stop Museum of the Vine and Wine (Museo de la Vid y el vino, approximately 1-hour drive) to learn about the history and culture of this wine making region. Transfer to Monte Xanic winery for wine and cheese tasting, followed by lunch (not included in price). Afternoon visit to Adobe Guadalupe winery (approximately 10 minutes drive).

Accommodation: Valle de Guadalupe

Day 4: Valle de Guadalupe

Breakfast in hotel and time to relax and enjoy the views, followed by wine pairing with truffles and time for lunch at a regional restaurant (not included in price).

Afternoon visits to Baron Balché and El Cielo wineries with tasting.

Accommodation: Valle de Guadalupe

Day 5: Return travel

Breakfast in hotel.

Transfer to Tijuana airport (approximately 2 hours) for flights back to **Puerto Vallarta, Guadalajara, or Mexico City - *flight times to be confirmed once we have purchased flight tickets.***
