Day of the Dead Michoacan Tour itinerary

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: City of Morelia - UNESCO World Heritage Site

6.00 am: Departure to Morelia (approximately 8 hours).

Afternoon arrival to Morelia for check-in at hotel, followed by walking tour through Morelia's historic

centre, and free time for dinner.

Accommodation: Morelia

Day 2: Magic Towns and Day of the Dead Celebrations

Note: we recommend taking a day pack with warm clothes for the evening, as we do not return to the hotel before evening activities.

Breakfast (included) in hotel, followed by departure to the Magic Town of Tzintzuntzan (approximately 1 hour transfer). Explanation of the Yácatas de Tzintzuntzan archaeological site (not accessible by vehicle on these dates, but optional walk to enter the archaeological site), and free time to explore the town and cemetery of Tzintzuntzan, where you can appreciate the impressive flower arrangements, altars, and offerings as they are put into place for the evening celebrations. Transfer to Pátzcuaro (approximately 30 minutes). Orientation from our guide, followed by free time for lunch and time to enjoy the impressive artisan market and Magic Town of Pátzcuaro.

6 pm: Dinner (included) in Pátzcuaro and chance to change clothing and rest before evening activities.

8 pm: Travel to the lakeside towns to see the impressive sights of the cemeteries glowing in candle light and the crowds of people celebrating the lives and memories of their lost loved ones. Approximate arrival time to hotel in Morelia: 1 am - dependent on traffic conditions.

Accommodation: Morelia

Day 3: Morelia and transfer to Guadalajara

Breakfast in the hotel (included), followed by free time in Morelia to enjoy this beautiful city and explore the altars on the main plaza.

2.30 pm: Departure for Guadalajara's historic centre (approximately 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours), arriving approximately 6 - 6.30 pm. Check-in at the hotel and free time for dinner.

Accommodation: Guadalajara

Day 4: Guadalajara

8 am: Breakfast (included), followed by a walking tour of Guadalajara's historic centre (or free time). 11 am: Transfer to Tlaquepaque (approximately 30 minutes) for free time and lunch (not included) in this artistic district of Guadalajara.

3 pm: Departure for return travel (approximately 4 ½ hours).
