

EXPERIENCE MEX-ECO TOURS

Queretaro & Bernal Tour Itinerary - Puerto Vallarta/Bucerias departure

This itinerary may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances/delays.

Day 1: León – *departure times will be confirmed upon booking of flights.*

Flights from Puerto Vallarta to León. Transfer to hotel for check-in and time for lunch, followed by walking tour of historic centre and visit to the famous leather stalls/stores of León. Optional evening meal with group (not included in price).

Accommodation: León.

Day 2: Querétaro

Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by travel to Querétaro (approximately 2 ½ hours travel time). Check-in at hotel followed by city tour and free time.

Accommodation: Querétaro.

Day 3: Wine and cheese

Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by departure to Tequisquiapan (approximately 1 ½ hours travel time). Walking tour/orientation in Tequisquiapan followed by visit to ranch cheese for making explanation, tasting and shopping. Afternoon: visit to vineyard. Visit includes a guided tour of the vineyards, production areas and a taste of two of their wines with a delicious lunch. Free time in the evening.

Accommodation: Tequisquiapan.

Day 4: Peña de Bernal, dairy and wine

Breakfast in hotel (included) followed by departure to Bernal for viewpoint of the world's 3rd largest monolith – Peña de Bernal, walking tour and free time for shopping. Visit to ranch cheese; for a 100% organic, dairy farm which produces dozens of award winning dairy products from milk and yoghurt to cheese, cream and cookies. Tour includes explanation of the grounds, cattle breeding program, recycling program and tasting (lunch included). Depart for Friexenet winery for explanation on the processes involved in creating their delicious sparkling wines, includes one sample.

Accommodation: Tequisquiapan.

Day 5: Return travel – *departure times will be confirmed upon booking of flights.*

Breakfast in hotel followed by departure for Mexico City airport for return flights to Puerto Vallarta.
